Reynolds Recycling Inc. recently opened a certified redemption center in Hauula, located south of the Hauula Kai Center at 54-290 Kamehameha Hwy., making it one step easier for residents to “go green” by recycling.

The redemption center is open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Saturday for HI-5 recyclables, and it also will buy non-ferrous scrap metal, including aluminum, copper and brass.



Reynolds also opened a new center on University Avenue, making its redemption network available at 38 locations islandwide. Windward sites already established are at Kahuku Sugar Mill, Koolau Center, Aikahi Park, Keolu Shopping Center and in Waimanalo.
